<b>PRIORITY 1 INSERT PRIORITY</b>	<p><b>Theft (In licensed premises)</b></p> <p>During the month of June 2010 there have been 22 reported thefts from licensed premises, eleven of which occurred within one particular licensed premises in Hays Galleria. Two suspects have been captured on CCTV for one offence and these images have been downloaded and circulated to all police officers on Southwark Borough in the hope that someone will identify them.</p> <p>Officers continue to be tasked with visiting this venue at least once per shift whilst in uniform and regularly speak to customers who are careless with their property (bags on backs of chairs or on the floor etc). We have been in contact with the company who manage this particular premises to discuss the problem of personal theft and are looking to recruit members of staff into the employer supported policing scheme. <b>PRIORITY 2 INSERT PRIORITY</b>	<p><b>Begging and Rough Sleeping</b></p> <p>Riverside Safer Neighbourhood Team recently attended a meeting held at the local council offices on Tooley Street together with members of the local street population team. One known "rough sleeper" was until recently housed in a local hostel but recently self harmed and as a result has been sectioned under the mental health act.</p> <p>Statements have also been taken from members of staff from local businesses concerning another habitual rough sleeper. This evidence is being collated to enable us to apply for an ASBO as other methods of engagement and support have failed with regards to this particular person.</p>
